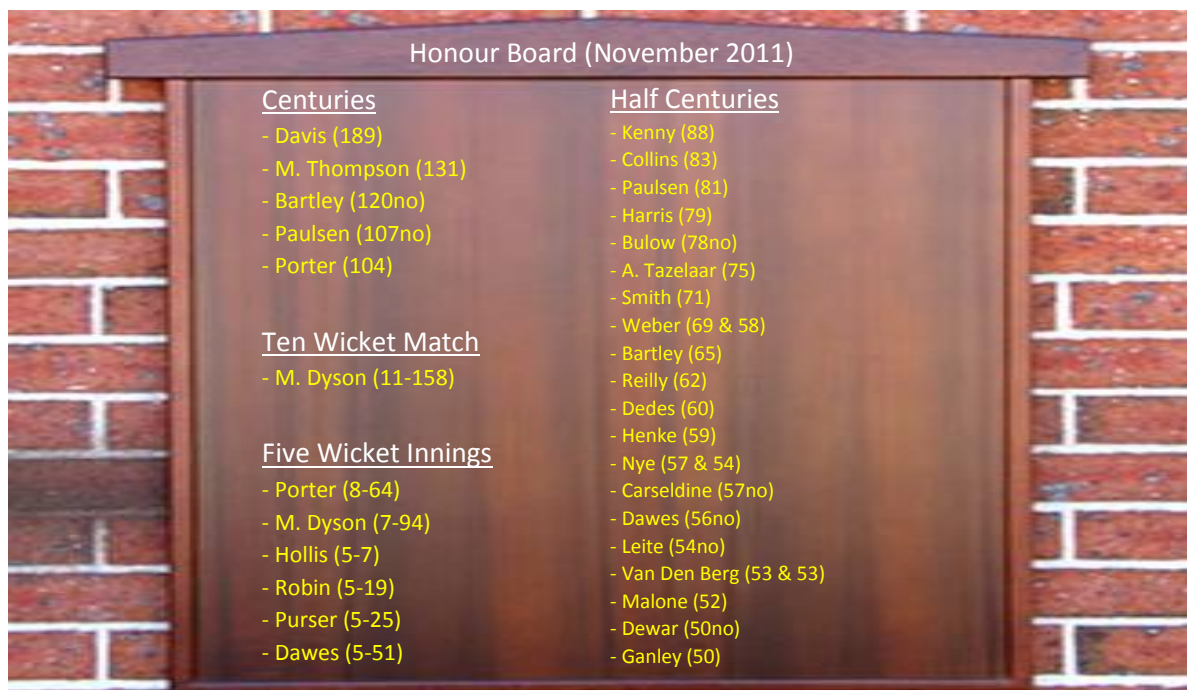

The Bob Spence Medal

The Bob Spence Medal is a prestigious award given to the **Player's Player** at WSDCC's end of season dinner. It is based on a 3-2-1 system (similar to the AFL's brownlow and NRL's Dally M votes), whereby players in each team are awarded points after each round. Note that T20 match votes are ½-weighted (1.5-1-0.5). The progressive points are able to be followed on MyCricket this season thanks to Matthew Dyson and Roger Prentice's assistance. Points will only be shown up until just after the Xmas rounds when they will be tallied secretly until the end of the season. The award is arguably the 'one to win' at the end of the season.

Some further details about Bob Spence are below.

Bob Spence (1920-1997) was Queensland Cricket's scorer from 1961 through to 1987-88, and scored more than 150 first class matches, including 16 Tests. He was Queensland Cricket's Treasurer from 1963 to 1988. Childhood polio prevented him from playing, but he served as a scorer and administrator for WSDCC and earned life membership. He was also made a life member of Queensland Cricket in 1972. [Source: QC Website]

Down the Club

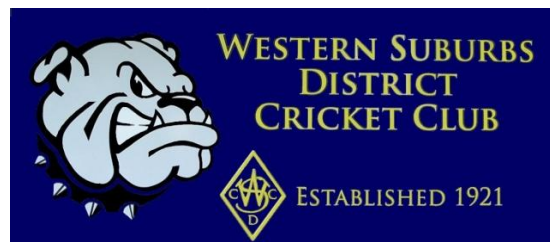


When you’re next down the club make sure you take the time to look up at the updated Honour Boards (thanks to Matt Dyson).

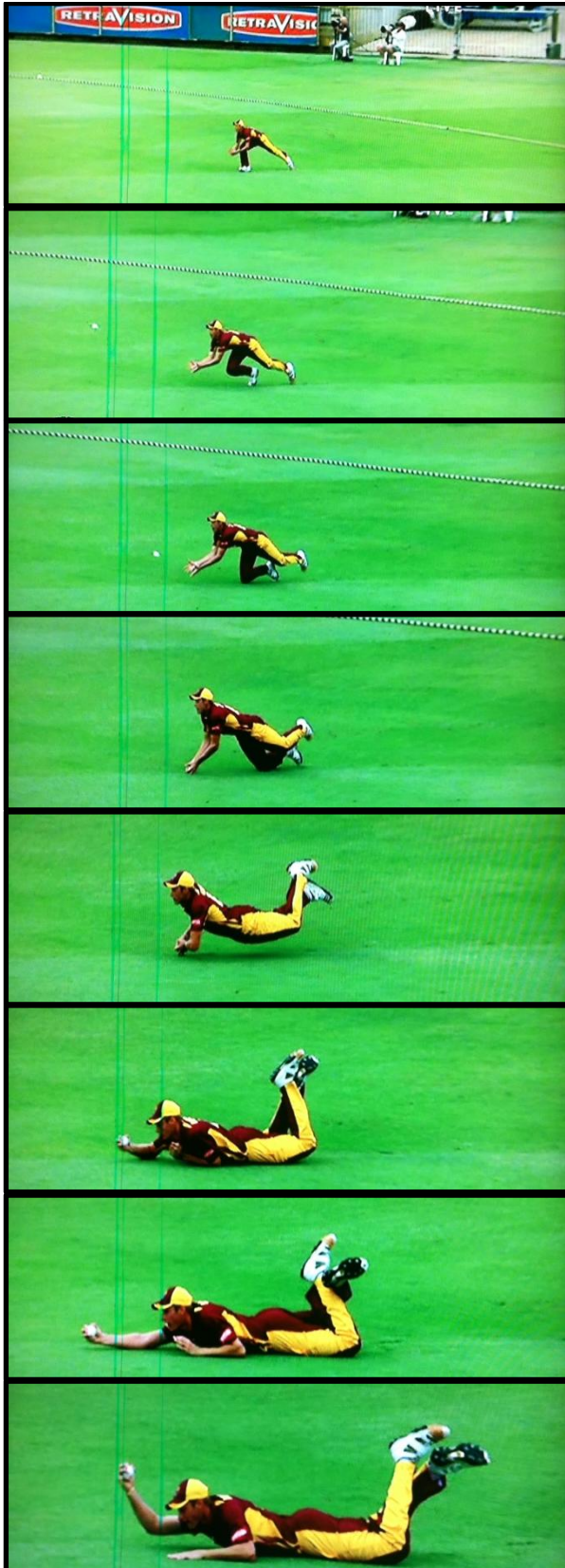
